

RESOLUTION NO. 22- 09

**A RESOLUTION ASSESSING/CONTINUING A ONE PERCENT (1%)
COUNTY WIDE RETAILER'S SALES TAX IN STEVENS COUNTY, KANSAS FOR
PROPERTY TAX RELIEF**

WHEREAS, the qualified electors of Stevens County should be permitted to decide the assessment of a one percent (1%) County Wide Retailer's Sales Tax; and

WHEREAS, said one percent (1%) County Wide Retailer's Sales Tax will not expire unless statutorily required to do so; and

WHEREAS, revenue derived from the sales tax is divided between Stevens County, the City of Moscow, and the City of Hugoton as determined by law.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF STEVENS COUNTY, KANSAS:**


- 1.) That a special question election be held in the manner prescribed by law on November 8, 2022 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Stevens County the following question:

Shall a County Wide one percent (1%) Retailer's Sales Tax be assessed (retained) all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.* for the purpose of property tax relief?

- 2.) Such extension of said sales tax, if approved, to take effect on July 1, 2023.
- 3.) This resolution shall become effective upon passage and its publication in the official county newspaper.
- 4.) The County Clerk is hereby directed to submit a certified copy of this resolution, upon passage by the electors, to the State Director of Taxation.




